

What to wear. No uniforms! So you're welcome to wear what you want. Please dress for the weather. We're there regardless - just like the old days. The new tradition is a Homecoming Black Out. Wear black if you want to.

It can get VERY windy out on the field. Band front members will work out what they're going to do when they arrive. Majorettes - you're on your own!

Sign in starts at 3:30 on **Friday October 20th**. If you can't make it at that time, catch up with us when you can. Report to the auditorium of the Mifflin County High School, 501 Eight St., Lewistown. An Act 80 day is on the schedule for that date, so maybe no after school traffic. The auditorium and band room can be accessed from the student parking lot located on the right side of the building. Door #10 (look for the white Subaru). Bring your instrument because practice is from 4:30-5:30 PM.

After practice, we will car pool to the Mifflin County Middle School (the old Lewistown High School). We have only 30 minutes to get everyone to the teacher's parking (cafeteria or dumpster) lot and lined up to march to Mitchell Field. That means - don't mess around!

We'll sit in the stands for the game. At half time, we'll line up and march onto the field to the fifty yard line where we'll play three songs and then get out of the way for the Homecoming Queen. Everyone has to move quickly so if you have mobility issues, let us know. You'll be able to enter the field through a gate near the 50 Yard line. After the show, we'll head back to the stands for the rest of the game. The new, old style march (Military Escort) will be played from the stands by the alumni band during the third quarter. After the game, everyone is asked to stay and watch our high school band perform their field show.

Your registration fee paid for your t-shirt and a bit left over to donate to the band. They can always use more. Bring money. The Music Boosters will be on hand with more opportunities. There is discussion this year for ordering sweat shirts instead of T-shirts since it will probably be cold by the end of October. Log into the Facebook page and voice your opinion.
